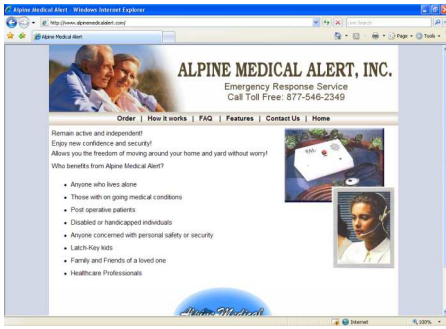

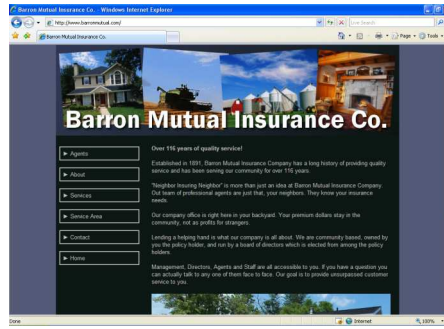

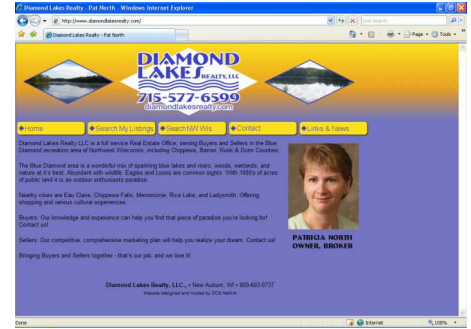

SafeLive makes email safe again with encrypted email

Is regular email safe?

No! Regular email is not safe! With regular email, sensitive information such as business information, customer data, intellectual property, and personal information can be easily seen by people who should not see it. Using SafeLive, your email message will be encrypted and secured by your fingerprint before it leaves your computer and will stay that way until it's opened by the intended recipient(s) when they swipe their fingerprint. There's no question about it; only those you intend can read your emails.

SafeLive Key Features:

- Your messages are secured using highly accurate biometrics.
- SafeLive integrates seamlessly with Outlook 2000, XP, 2003, and 2007.
- You can send secure, encrypted messages to any email address, even if the recipient does not have a SafeLive account or a fingerprint reader.
- SafeLive uses your existing email account.
- There is no additional IT infrastructure required.
- SafeLive is very easy to use!



How does it work?

When you scan your fingerprint to send the message, your fingerprint model (a mathematical representation) is sent to the secure SafeLive key server to be verified and a new, completely random, encryption key is created. SafeLive then encrypts the message and sends it to the recipients via an encrypted attachment in a standard email message. If the message is intercepted by anyone (even system administrators), that person will not be able to read the contents. When a recipient opens the email and scans a fingerprint, the fingerprint model is sent to the secure SafeLive key server for authentication, and the message's encryption key is returned. SafeLive can then decrypt the message. When the user closes the message, the unencrypted message is deleted so it always remains in its secure state.

What about my non-SafeLive correspondents?

No problem. Using the "Message Pickup" feature, you can exchange secure messages with anyone, even if the other person doesn't have a fingerprint reader. When you send a message to an unenrolled (non-SafeLive) email address, the message contents are encrypted and stored on the SafeLive secure message server. The recipient will then get a notification via email that he/she has received a secure message from you. The notification will contain a link that he/she must click to open the message. Then, he/she will log in using their password. The first time someone is sent a secure message using message pickup, an additional security question can be used to prove your recipient's identity. A password for receiving future secure messages can then be created.
